As you can see in the above table, we have spent more than the grant we received for sports premium funding. COVID19 put a stop to many of our planned coaching activities.

From July 31st 2019, it is a statutory requirement to publish the percentage of pupils in our Year 6 cohort who can:

- swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres.
- use a range of strokes effectively.

- perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations.

Unfortunately, due to the COVID pandemic, we were unable to visit the swimming baths after March 2020 to ascertain who could attain the latter targets.
